



## KALLANGUR LADIES BOWLING CLUB CONDITIONS OF PLAY

### COMPETITION: 2024 CONSISTENCY SINGLES

All competitions to be played in accordance with the **Laws of the Sport of Bowls** as per amended from time to time and in conjunction with the KMBC Conditions of Play.

To be **eligible to enter** the competition all players **must be fully financial members** by the **close of nominations**.

Competition Opens on **5/9/2024**, Closes on **26/9/240** and is called for **17/10/24**

Games may be **RE-SCHEDULED**, by mutual agreement of both Skips of teams. Re-scheduled games must **NOT DELAY** competition in any way. Should the re-scheduled game **NOT** be played before the next round the instigator of the change will be awarded a **FORFEIT**. (CoP 7 (a) (7))

**NB: There are two (2) play days Thursday and Saturday for working players.**

Both Skips are to notify the Games Director of the intention to re-schedule a game. Written appeals may be made to the Controlling Body within 48 hours.

This is a **knockout competition**.

Each player will play with a set of **4 bowls**.

The game will consist of **25 ends**.

**Trial ends** one each way will be allowed prior to commencement of play.

**No FINAL** can be won on a forfeit (exceptions may be adjudicated on by the CB).

**Movement of players** is restricted in accordance with Law A.4.1

“After delivering their first bowl, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances: after the opponent’s delivery of their third and fourth bowl.”

Bad weather or circumstances beyond the Club’s control may necessitate changes. The Games Director will reschedule postponed games on the next available date and notify the Skips.

### **SCORING:**

- **ONLY** bowls within the yardstick will count 4,3,2,1.
- A player will lose ten (10) points for a dead end and five (5) points for moving the Jack more than the length of the yardstick or comes to rest in the ditch OR causes the opponent’s bowl to do the same.
- In the event of a tied score extra ends shall be played to determine a winner (Law 28.1)

**The current registered Kallangur Shirt** must be worn with white or green trousers, shorts or skirts which must have BA logo. White socks. Approved head wear and bowls shoes. (CoP 2)

**The Controlling Body has the power to amend the programme of the event as it considers it necessary. Refer to the working Members Policy**
